Sea Turtle, Inc. - An education, research, rescue and rehabilitation center.

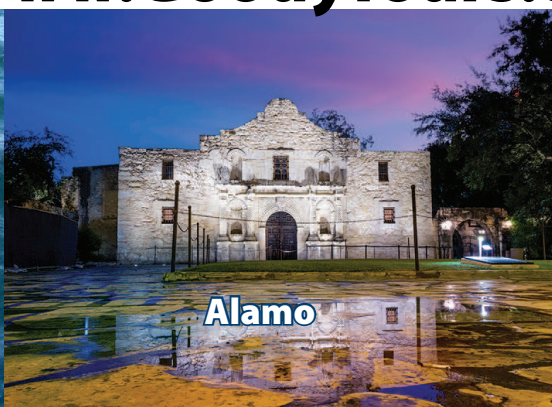
The Sea Life Center - Tour this indescribable sea life center to see some of Padre Island's aquatic life.
