## **AMERICAN SIDE**

*Niagara Scenic Trolley* - An enjoyable 30-minute narrated overview of the park.

*Maid of the Mist* - Take a boat ride to the base of the falls.

*Whirlpool Aero Car* - Witness spectacular views of the Niagara Whirlpool and the river's rapids as you ride 3,500 feet across the Niagara Gorge.

*Buffalo and Erie Naval and Military Park* - Ships, aircraft and exhibits from WWI to present.

*Cave of the Winds* - Ride an elevator to the bottom of Bridal Veil Falls and feel the mist from the falls.

Tom Ridge Environmental Center - educational and research center for the Presque Isle Peninsula in Pennsylvania.

## **CANADIAN SIDE (PASSPORT REQUIRED)**

*Niagara Parkway* - Travel on this scenic road running along the Niagara River in Ontario. Sir Winston Churchill called it "the prettiest Sunday drive in the world."

*Whirlpool Rapids Gorge* - The rapids generated here are among the wildest, formidable and most dangerous in the world.

*Floral Clock* - The intricate designs on the face of the timepiece are created with up to 16,000 bedding plants.

*Niagara Parks' Botanical Gardens* - Enjoy the beauty of gardens, an aviary and a world-famous rose garden.

*Niagara Butterfly Conservatory* - An award-winning tropical oasis with butterflies of all colors and species.
