At the *Mitchell, SD, Prehistoric Indian Village*, discovered in 1910, learn about the people who lived here 1,100 years ago.

Historic *Wall Drug Store* was an oasis, offering weary travelers free ice water. Nearly 2 million visitors each year enjoy the history plus 5¢ coffee, free ice water, and home-style meals.

Wonder at the *Devil's Tower National Monument*, a mysterious geologic feature in the Black Hills of Wyoming. Native American cultures regard this as a sacred space. (photo above)

Tour the *Eagle Butte Coal Mine* which produces 41% of our nation's coal. Their restoration process restores mining lands.

Ten Sleep Saloon - good food in a friendly atmosphere serving steak, seafood and other comfort-food.

Stay at the *Gold Hotel/Casino*, in Deadwood SD, nestled at the base of hillsides and surrounded by mountains.

Chug through the Black Hills on the *1880 Train*.

Chapel in the Hills in Rapid City, SD, is an exact replica of the Borgund stave church in Norway.

Stroll through the *Stuhr Museum of the Prairie Pioneer* in Grand Island, NE, preserves the legacy of the pioneers who settled the plains of central Nebraska in the late 19th Century.
